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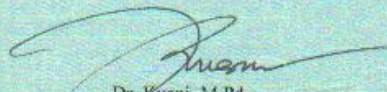
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ABSTRAK

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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Problem

Reading is the process of learning that is done by students with the purpose of grasping information such as, technological development, social politics, education, and so on. The information can be gotten from the book, internet, and other materials like magazine, newspaper, articles, etc. Through reading, the students can increase their knowledge.

Materials are one of the important things that should be considered. It gives an effect toward students' motivation in reading comprehension. Therefore, the English teacher has to pay more attention to this case. The teacher can vary the materials in order to avoid a monotonous in teaching learning process.

The writer's observation at Senior High School shows that the materials given by teacher was boring and could not stimulate the student's interest in learning reading. In addition, not all of the students participated in reading class. In this case the teacher should revise the materials used in teaching learning process. The material should be interesting for the majority of the students.

Relate to explanation above, the teacher's creativity to bring some materials that are interesting for the students into classrooms is needed. In order to make the students eager to be active; mystery stories can solve this problem since mystery stories provide interesting and enjoyable material in the language classroom. Mystery stories also provide useful sources of practice and reinforcement in the areas of critical thinking and deductive reasoning.

From this statement, it can be concluded that mystery story is a material in which the students should be critical to synthesize, analyze clues and fact in interpreting the story. Therefore, the writer is interested to use mystery stories in teaching reading.

1.2 Limitation of the Problem

In teaching learning process the teacher often find difficulties such as in creating activities and motivating the students. There are some materials that have already given by the teacher in teaching reading such as paraphrasing, summary and etc. These activities seem would not be able to involve all the students. The effect, most of the students are not motivated them. They get bored of these activities. The teacher is hoped to try the new materials which is called reading mystery stories to motivate the students in learning reading.
