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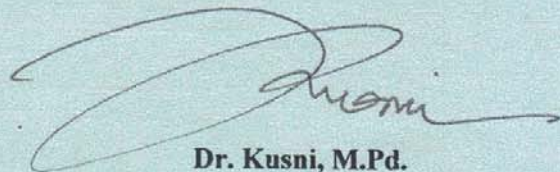
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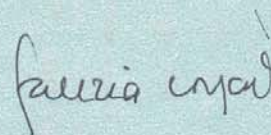
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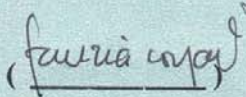
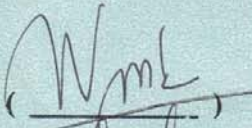
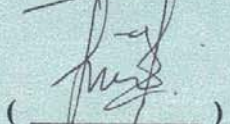
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ABSTRAK

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Salah satu hambatan yang dihadapi guru dalam mengajar berbicara, membaca, dan menulis dalam bahasa Inggris kepada anak-anak adalah kurangnya penguasaan kosakata. Mereka sering lupa kosakata yang telah mereka pelajari. Hal ini disebabkan oleh jaranginya guru menggunakan media yang tepat dan menarik serta mudah diingat oleh siswa. Makalah ini menjelaskan salah satu media yang bisa digunakan oleh guru dalam pengajaran bahasa Inggris yaitu dengan menggunakan media *Pop-Up*. Dengan menggunakan *Pop-Up*, guru membuat sebuah halaman atau buku yang memiliki bagian yang dapat bergerak atau berunsur 3 dimensi. *Pop Up* memberikan visualisasi tentang kosakata yang lebih menarik. Tampilan gambar yang terlihat lebih memiliki dimensi, gambar yang dapat bergerak ketika halamannya dibuka atau bagiannya digeser hingga bagian dapat berubah bentuk. Jenis kosakata yang bisa disampaikan melalui *Pop-Up* bisa sangat beragam mulai dari gambar hewan, buah-buahan, dan lain-lain. Dengan menggunakan *Pop-Up* sebagai media dalam pengajaran bahasa Inggris untuk anak-anak, diharapkan guru dapat meningkatkan minat siswa untuk belajar bahasa Inggris. Dengan demikian siswa menjadi lebih tertarik untuk belajar bahasa Inggris karena mereka mampu mengingat kosakata lebih mudah.

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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Problem

Vocabulary is one element that links four skills (listening, reading, speaking and writing) all together. In addition, vocabulary affects the mastering of those four language skills.
